Evenings at the Festival will have exhilarating performances by acclaimed artistes such as Indian Carnatic vocalist **Aruna Sairam**; Punjabi folk singer **Dolly Guleria** who is carrying forward the legacy of the legendary musician Surinder Kaur; singer-songwriter **Harpreet Singh**, and many more!

While the Morning and Evening Music will be free and open to all, a specially curated and magical 'Delegate Experience', spread over 2 and a half days, with languid afternoon discourses on poetry, heritage walks across important sites, and the partaking of Amritsar's incomparable cuisine, will be the Festival's hallmarks.
